
Summary

Psychological support of work with gifted children in primary school

Definition of children's talent is being given in the article, taking its psychological structure in consideration. Typological approach, presented towards the phenomena of talent, considers favorable way of a gifted child's psychological development, and "disharmonic" types of psychological development of a child with signs of talent.
